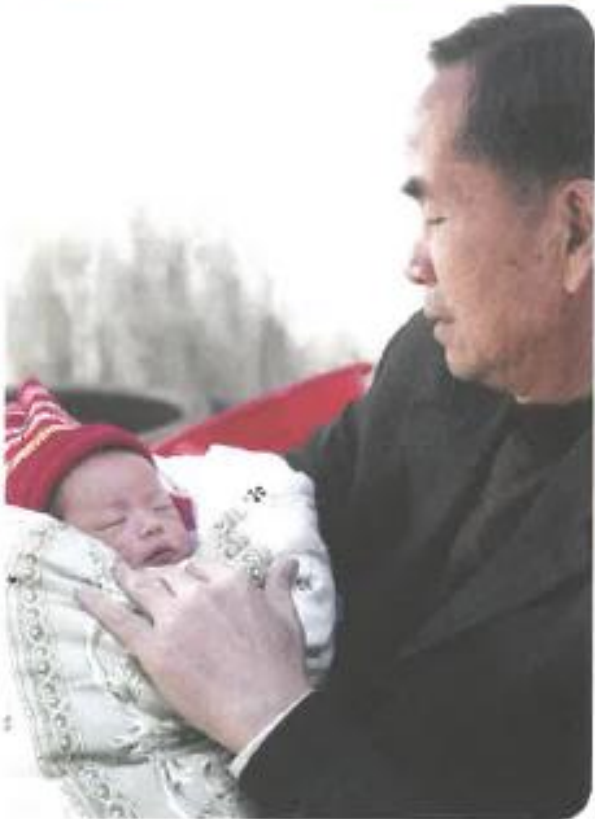

### Psalms 139:13-14


For you created my inmost being;
