- ✓ Teaching sacramental preparation courses to small and larger groups (baptism, first reconciliation, first communion, confirmation, marriage prep, RCIA, RCIT, or RCIA)
- ✓ Running a small faith study group
- ✓ Helping out with children's liturgy, children's catechism, Cat Chat, VBS or Catechesis of the Good Shepherd
- ✓ Getting involved with the youth group
- ✓ Helping with wedding rehearsals
- ✓ Visiting the sick or isolated
- ✓ Being part of the grief group team
- ✓ Helping out with the group for those who are separated or divorced
- ✓ Helping or leading the planning of events or supporting the ministries with their special events and retreats
- ✓ Helping with record keeping and administrative duties for ministries, events, and programs
- ✓ Coordinating a ministry team or an event
- ✓ Being a Eucharistic minister, lector, sacristan, or altar server
- ✓ Being a greeter
- ✓ Helping with hospitality and Monday morning coffee time
- ✓ Helping to straighten and tidy hymnals and pews after Mass
- ✓ Helping provide music for Mass or ministry events
- ✓ Coordinating or helping out with fund raising events

- ✓ Helping with grounds keeping and gardening
- ✓ Assisting with minor building maintenance
- ✓ Being 'on-call' to assist with duties related to funerals and the cemetery
